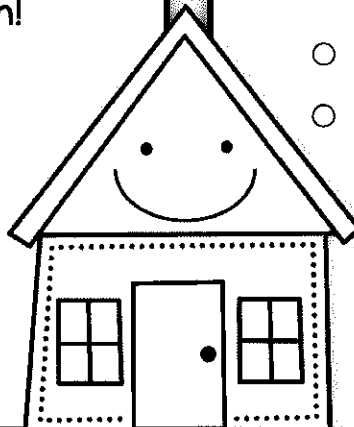
Vocabulary
