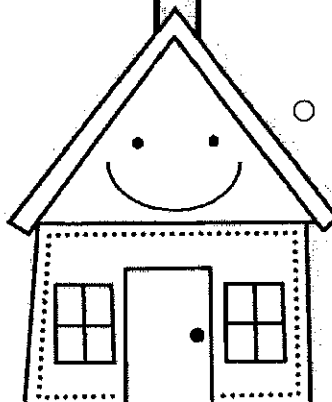
Vocabulary
