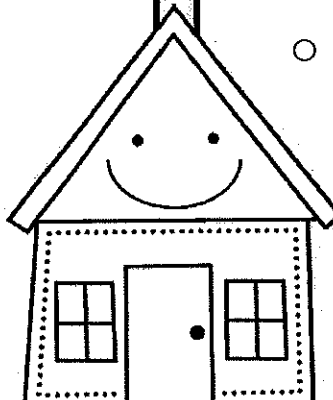
Vocabulary
