## Poem of the Week

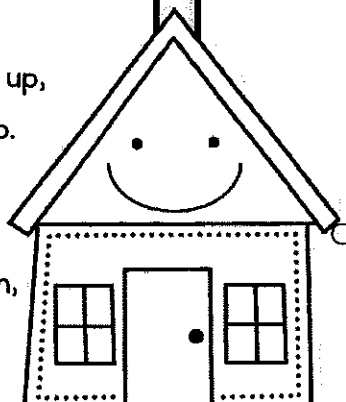
### All the Leaves are Falling Down
